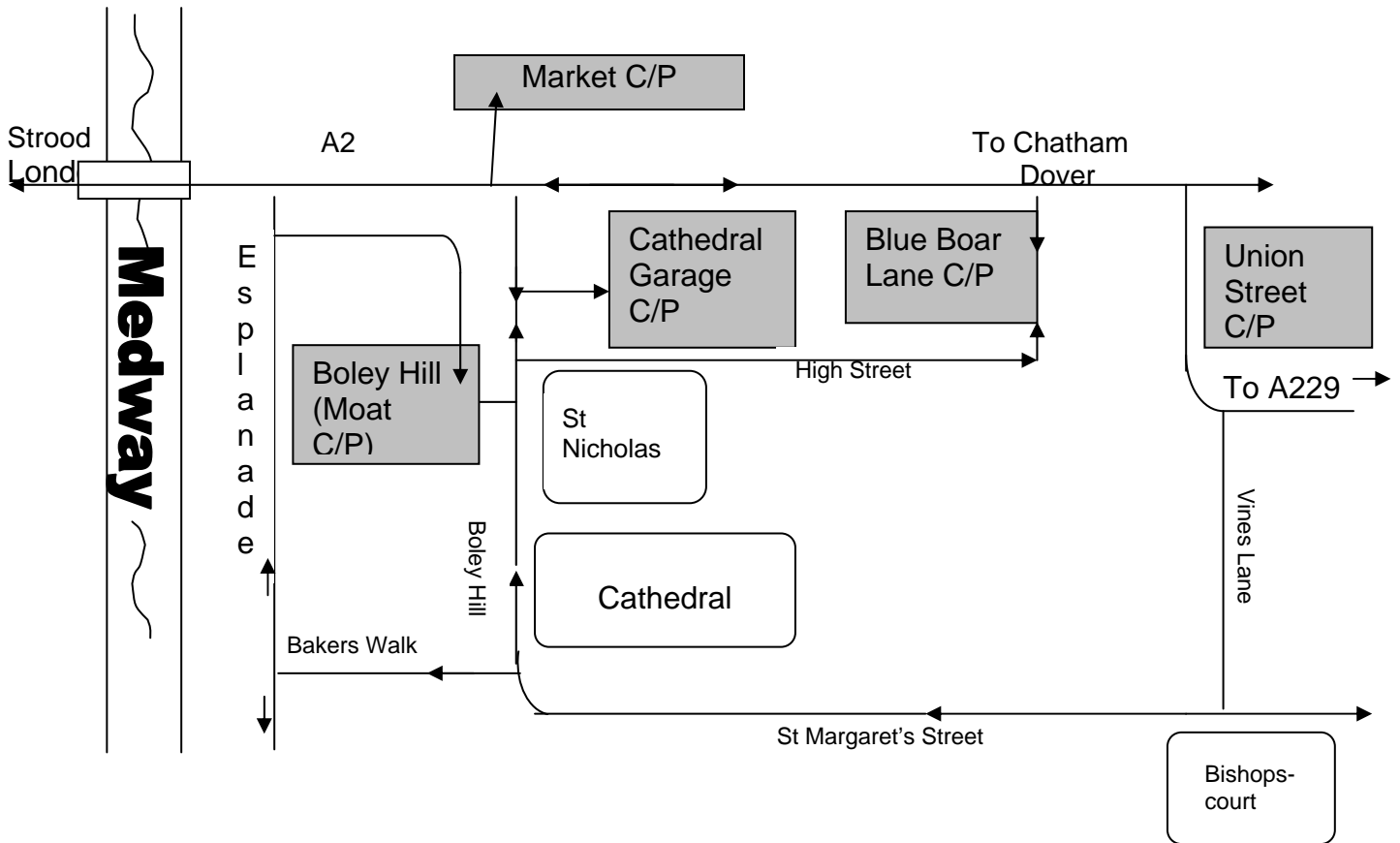


- There is little free off-street parking in Rochester
- Boley Hill (Castle Moat) - Pay and Display (5 hours max)
- Cathedral Garage - Pay and Display (5 hours max – pay until 10 p.m.)
- Blue Boar Lane - Pay and Display (5 hours max – pay until 10 p.m.)
- Market Car Park – Pay and Display (all day – pay until 10 p.m.)
- The Esplanade - Pay and Display (all day – free after 7 p.m.)
- Union Street Car Park - Pay and Display (all day – free after 7 p.m.)
- The car park at the Civic Centre (just over the bridge in Strood) is also available on Saturdays.

If coming on **M2 from London** leave at junction 3 follow signs for A229 Chatham

If coming on **M25 take M26/M20** leave at junction 6 follow signs A229 Chatham

BOTH WILL ARRIVE AT LARGE ROUNDABOUT AT TOP OF HILL

Take B2097 (marked Borstal and Rochester). After a few miles, where the road turns sharp right, turn left into Vines Lane (mind the speed humps!). At the end (opposite Bishops-court), turn right into St Margaret's Street. St Nicholas Church is next to the Cathedral.

If coming on **M2 from Dover** leave at junction 3 follow signs for Chatham/Maidstone, at second roundabout follow signs for Buckmore Park and Borstal. This will bring you to a round-about under a fly-over. Carry straight on – you are now on the B2097 (follow instructions above)

The centre of Rochester is closed to traffic between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Saturdays and Parking on **SUNDAY** is FREE!
